HST faculty Jeff Karp announces biomaterials surgical video library

HST faculty member Jeff Karp, PhD, has spearheaded the creation of a new downloadable lecture library as part of the [Biomaterials Surgical Video Library](#). The new collection features streaming video of lectures and seminars as well as downloadable presentations detailing a variety of biomaterials topics.

"There are several professors around the world who now use the site to augment their biomaterials lectures," said Karp, who is founder and chair of the Biomaterials Education Special Interest Group and is an active member of the Education and Professional Development Committee at the [Society for Biomaterials](#).

In addition to the lecture library, the site contains a surgical video library, also organized by Karp. This collection of videos helps engineers and scientists who are designing new materials learn about the clinical constraints of surgical procedures involving biomaterials.

The site should prove to be a valuable educational resource for the HST community. In addition, HST researchers can use this site to share their own discoveries and techniques at the interface of biomaterials and medicine with a wide audience. The site currently receives over 1000 visits per day from researchers across the globe.
